AN ACT

RELATING TO WELFARE REFORM; PROVIDING FOR STATE OPERATIONS OF ADMINISTRATIVE FUNCTIONS IN ORDER FOR INDIAN TRIBES, PUEBLOS OR NATIONS TO RECEIVE AND EXPEND THEIR OWN TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE FOR NEEDY FAMILIES BLOCK GRANTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE--NEEDY FAMILIES BLOCK GRANTS.--The human services department shall develop and provide on an ongoing basis to any Indian tribe, pueblo or nation a system that includes recordkeeping, tracking and compilation for any Indian tribe, pueblo or nation to receive and expend its own temporary assistance for needy families block grants pursuant to the federal Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunities Reconciliation Act of 1996.
