MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR A NEW SWIMMING POOL IN MCKINLEY COUNTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the New Mexico office of Indian affairs for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for the purpose of conducting a feasibility study for a swimming pool in a Navajo community, including rights of way, archeological clearance and environmental assessment, located in McKinley county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
