BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the New Mexico office of Indian affairs for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for the purpose of providing housing assistance to ten veterans in the Pinedale Navajo chapter area in McKinley county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
