AN ACT

RELATING TO LAW ENFORCEMENT: ESTABLISHING CERTAIN PROCEDURES FOR OPERATIONS CONDUCTED BY SPECIAL WEAPONS AND TACTICAL UNITS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SPECIAL WEAPONS AND TACTICAL UNITS--UNIFORMS. --

A law enforcement officer who participates in operations conducted by special weapons and tactical units shall wear a standard service uniform with standard identification or a special raid uniform that clearly identifies the officer's affiliation with a local, state or federal law enforcement agency and the officer's badge number. A special raid uniform shall identify the officer's affiliation and badge number on the front and back of the uniform in letters and numbers that are not smaller than five inches in height and that are light reflecting.

- В. A law enforcement officer who participates in operations conducted by special weapons and tactical units shall not wear ski masks, hoods or other apparel that conceal facial features.
- If bullet-proof vests or other outer garments are worn by a law enforcement officer who participates in operations conducted by special weapons and tactical units, the vest or outer garment shall identify the officer's affiliation and badge number on the front and back of the vest or garment in letters and numbers that are not smaller than five inches in height and that are light reflecting.

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. -- The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 1997.

## AN ACT

RELATING TO LAW ENFORCEMENT; ESTABLISHING CERTAIN PROCEDURES FOR OPERATIONS CONDUCTED BY SPECIAL WEAPONS AND TACTICAL UNITS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. SPECIAL WEAPONS AND TACTICAL UNITS--UNIFORMS.--

A. A law enforcement officer who participates in operations conducted by special weapons and tactical units shall wear a standard service uniform with standard identification or a special raid uniform that clearly identifies the officer's affiliation with a local or state law enforcement agency. A special raid uniform shall identify the officer's affiliation on the front outermost layer of the uniform in letters that are not smaller than five inches in height.

B. A law enforcement officer who participates in operations conducted by special weapons and tactical units may

wear a ski mask, hood or any other apparel that conceals his facial features when tear gas, diversion devices or diversion tactics might be used during an operation.

- C. The provisions of this section shall not be interpreted to limit a law enforcement officer's discretion to use camouflage clothing or any other apparel as a tactic to make an entry or make an arrest when there are circumstances attendant to the entry or arrest that place the officer's life at risk.
- D. A law enforcement officer who is attached to or affiliated with a special weapons and tactical unit shall acquire forty hours of tactical training each fiscal year. A law enforcement officer shall not participate in any operations conducted by a special weapons or tactical unit if he has not acquired the required amount of tactical training in any fiscal year.

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. -- The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 1997.
