## A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE GOVERNOR AND THE NEW MEXICO STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC EDUCATION TO ENDORSE MEANS AND METHODS OF IMPROVING THE TEACHING OF NATURAL RESOURCE, ENVIRONMENTAL AND AGRICULTURAL EDUCATION IN NEW MEXICO CLASSROOMS AND RECOGNIZING THE IMPORTANCE OF A PRIVATELY FUNDED EFFORT.

WHEREAS, New Mexico is a rural state that possesses great natural resources and is a major producer of a wide variety of agricultural products and services; and

WHEREAS, many New Mexico students and teachers are becoming removed from an understanding of the basics of water resources and land preservation in an arid environment and are losing sight of the importance of natural resources in the state's economy and culture; and

WHEREAS, there is a great need for the creation of an

environmental and agricultural curriculum and associated resource library for New Mexico students and teachers; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico farm and livestock bureau, the state's largest and oldest private agricultural organization, is currently committing funding, staff and resources to such a statewide education program to the benefit of all New Mexicans; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico farm and livestock bureau is also funding a statewide environmental camp and providing scholarships for all its participants;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the governor and the state department of public education be urged to endorse the efforts of the numerous organizations involved in a program to expand and improve on natural resource, environmental and agricultural education in New Mexico public schools.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the governor and the state department of public education be urged to provide assistance where needed from the department of agriculture, the natural resources conservation service, the state land office, the water resources institute, the New Mexico state university college of agriculture and home economics, the cooperative extension service or other appropriate state agencies in an effort to improve educational opportunities for New Mexico students and teachers.
