 - C. graduate medical education funds; and
- D. the appropriateness of the tuitions for graduate health professional education programs and whether certain tuitions should be higher than for other graduate level programs to reflect the high cost of training; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the commission on higher education report on this assessment to the appropriate legislative interim committee by October 15, 1997; and
