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A JOINT MEMORIAL

FOR THE HEALTH CARE REFORM COMMITTEE

REQUESTING THE NEW MEXICO HEALTH POLICY COMMISSION TO WORK WITH THE TAXATION AND REVENUE DEPARTMENT TO ADOPT UNIFORM DEFINITIONS AND REPORTING REQUIREMENTS REGARDING CHARITY CARE FOR HEALTH CARE FACILITIES AND TO ESTABLISH MINIMUM ACCOUNTABILITY STANDARDS.

WHEREAS, hospitals and other health care facilities provide uncompensated health care services; and

WHEREAS, no consistent method exists for defining and identifying bad debts, charity care, discounts and allowances and other forms of uncompensated care; and

WHEREAS, hospitals and other health care facilities reportedly use a number of different policies and procedures for collecting amounts owed; and

WHEREAS, inconsistent reporting of uncompensated care

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limits the state's ability to assess objectively the amount of health care services being provided for which no reimbursement is available or received: and

WHEREAS, inconsistent measures do not permit accurate assessment of the magnitude of cost-shifting or its potential effect on health planning; and

WHEREAS. it is in the interest of the state to derive a benefit in exchange for tax exemptions and deductions;

NOW. THEREFORE. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the New Mexico health policy commission be requested to work with the taxation and revenue department to adopt uniform definitions and standard measures for uncompensated care and to require reporting of uncompensated care to the state; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that cost shifting of health care costs be uniformly tracked and reported and its impact on health care delivery in the state be assessed; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that minimum levels of charity care for hospitals and other health care facilities be proposed or adopted to govern an entity's right to relevant tax exemptions and deductions; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be sent to the secretary of taxation and revenue and the chairman of the New Mexico health policy commission.
