11	REQUESTING THE NEW MEXICO HEALTH POLICY COMMISSION TO WORK WITH
12	APPROPRIATE EXECUTIVE AGENCIES AND LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEES TO
13	ESTABLISH MEASURES TO ACHIEVE STATE GOALS FOR HEALTH BUDGETING
14	AND PLANNING PURPOSES, TO IDENTIFY ELECTRONIC REPORTING
15	REQUIREMENTS ON HEALTH CARE FOR ALL GOVERNMENT AGENCIES AND TO
16	REQUIRE TRACKING AND REPORTING OF HEALTH CARE REVENUE STREAMS.
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18	WHEREAS, there should be performance measures for health
19	programs that help the state to evaluate the effectiveness of
20	its health care delivery system and determine whether the
21	state's health policy is being achieved; and
22	WHEREAS, widespread variation exists among health
23	facilities and programs in the measures used for reporting
24	program impacts; and
25	WHEREAS, a lack of agreement in state government on what

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constitutes health care has led to fragmented data and limited ability to analyze, plan, develop budgets and demonstrate accountability for health care services; and

WHEREAS, administrative, overhead and non-direct service costs are not separately accounted for in most government health care programs, making it virtually impossible to assess resources used for direct services; and

WHEREAS, under current statutes, counties are only required to report on the amount and use of their indigent claims fund, which reportedly reflects only about thirty-two percent of county revenues supporting health care; and

WHEREAS, the department of finance and administration has the authority to require more complete data from counties on total revenues used for health care purposes; and

WHEREAS, availability of regularly collected data on government revenues used for health care would enhance state planning and the generation of policy and budget development without substantially increasing administrative costs or reporting burdens;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the New Mexico health policy commission be requested to work together with appropriate executive agencies and legislative committees to establish and implement standard measures to achieve state health goals for budgeting and planning purposes, to identify electronic reporting

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requirements on health care for all government agencies and to require tracking and reporting of health care revenue streams; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that protocols should be established for the standardization and electronic reporting of core health data elements to the New Mexico health policy commission by government entities providing or paying for health care services; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the department of finance and administration, in coordination with the New Mexico health policy commission, cooperate to encourage or require counties to report on all county revenues used for health care to include all sources of revenue and appropriate specifics on the expenditures and services provided; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the New Mexico health policy commission report on its progress to the appropriate legislative interim committee by October 1, 1997; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be sent to the secretary of finance and administration, the chairman of the legislative finance committee, the chairman of the New Mexico health policy commission and the director of the New Mexico association of counties.
