# A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE STATE HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT, THE CITY OF LAS CRUCES, THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE NEW MEXICO CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION TO COOPERATE TO THE FULLEST EXTENT POSSIBLE TO OBTAIN FUNDS FOR AND COMPLETE CONSTRUCTION OF APPROXIMATELY FOURTEEN MILES OF IMPROVEMENTS TO UNITED STATES HIGHWAY 70 IN DONA ANA COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the city of Las Cruces and its suburbs, as well as nearby communities, have grown tremendously in recent years, increasing the city's population by thirty-seven and eight-tenths percent and the county's by forty and six-tenths percent during the 1980s; and

WHEREAS, the highest growth rate in the area is occuring in the census tracts immediately adjacent to United States highway 70;

WHEREAS, United States highway 70 is a major feeder route connecting Las Cruces with White Sands Missile Range, Alamogordo and Ruidoso on the east and those locations with Deming, Lordsburg and Tucson on the west; and

WHEREAS, the number of vehicle trips per day through the interstate 25 and United States highway 70 interchange has increased by about twenty-five percent over the past five years and has the highest traffic count of any highway in the city; and

WHEREAS, job centers crucial to the economy of Las Cruces and the state such as White Sands Missile Range and Johnson Space Center are dependent on United States highway 70 for transportation access, as are public schools and industrial and commercial facilities in the area; and

WHEREAS, the accident rate along that segment of highway is unacceptably high, resulting in citizen complaints and demands for improvements; and

WHEREAS, a state study of the highway corridor completed in the late 1980s recommends reconstruction of United States highway 70 to provide for controlled access and to increase its capacity; and

WHEREAS, such improvements will provide for safety and ensured economic development and expansion of space-related facilities:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE

STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the state highway and transportation department, the United States department of transportation and the New Mexico congressional delegation be requested to cooperate to the fullest extent possible to obtain adequate funds for the completion of construction of improvements to approximately 14 miles of United States highway 70 in Dona Ana county; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the state highway and transportation department focus its right-of-way acquisitions and initial construction on the fourteen miles of roadway in Dona Ana county between interstate 25 and the community of Organ; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the secretary of highway and transportation, the secretary of the United States department of transportation, the City of Las Cruces and the New Mexico congressional delegation.
