#### INTRODUCED BY

#### A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THAT STATE AGENCIES, POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS OF THE STATE AND OTHER ENTITIES WHOSE AUTHORITY PERMITS THE ADOPTION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF REGULATIONS TO CONSIDER, EVALUATE AND AVOID UNNECESSARY IMPACTS AND EFFECTS ON THE PRIVATE PROPERTY RIGHTS OF NEW MEXICO RESIDENTS.

WHEREAS, government regulation may and does invade and restrict the lives and fortunes of the residents of this state by reducing the value and uses of private property; and

WHEREAS, rights inherent in and associated with the ownership of private property are constitutionally protected by the fourteenth amendment to the United States constitution as well as by Article 2, Section 20 of the constitution of New Mexico, which reads: "[p]rivate property shall not be taken or damaged for public use without just compensation"; and

WHEREAS, agencies of government, state, municipal, county and other special or district agencies as well as governing boards of municipal and county governments have been granted authority by law to enact and implement regulations to govern the procedures, process and substance of their statutory authority; and

WHEREAS, government action in enacting and implementing regulations, although intended to be done in the public interest and for the public welfare, often may and does infringe on the rights of private property ownership by reducing the value, limiting the use of or otherwise adversely impacting privately owned property of New Mexico residents; and

WHEREAS, regulations should be enacted and implemented to advance only legitimate government interests, without infringing upon private property ownership; and

WHEREAS, protection of private property ownership is an appropriate public interest and as a responsibility of government, at all levels, should be considered in any enactment of regulations; and

WHEREAS, avoidance of regulations that result in an inadvertent negative impact upon private property is a goal to be achieved by all agencies at all levels of government;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that all agencies of government, including state, municipal, county and other special or district agencies,

be encouraged to enact only those regulations that to the most limited extent possible achieve legitimate governmental interests sought by the agency, yet do not unnecessarily reduce the value of private property or otherwise infringe upon its ownership in this state; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the governor for distribution to all state government agencies, boards, commissions, committees, task forces and offices; and to all municipal and county governments in the state for distribution to each of their respective agenci es.
