A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION STUDY COMMITTEE TO CONSIDER ESTABLISHMENT OF A PERSONNEL CATEGORY OF SCHOOL COUNSELORS.

WHEREAS, elementary, middle, junior and high school children are being subjected to unprecedented social stresses, including fragmentation of families, drug and alcohol abuse, child abuse, poverty and violence; and

WHEREAS, an increasing number of these children are exhibiting symptoms of distress such as emotional disorders, academic underachievement, disruptive behavior, juvenile delinquency and withdrawal; and

WHEREAS, counseling provided within public schools can reduce drug abuse, dropout rates, unemployment and incarceration; and

WHEREAS, the state can help reduce academic, social and

emotional problems of students by enhancing the availability and quality of public school counseling programs; and

WHEREAS, school dropouts, gang members, pregnant teens and substance abusing youth are burdens on the taxpayer and contribute to rising crime; and

WHEREAS, school counselors contribute positively to students' progress and development, the school environment, student self-discipline, school attendance and academic achievement:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the legislative education study committee be requested to study the establishment of a personnel category of school counselors in the public schools; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that school counseling programs be studied independently at the elementary, middle, junior and high school levels, including national pupil-counselor ratios, position statements, student expectations and pay scales; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the legislative education study committee make recommendations on school counseling programs to the legislature by December 1, 1997; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the members of the legislative education study committee.
