A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION STUDY COMMITTEE TO STUDY
THE FEASIBILITY OF INCLUDING A COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENT FACTOR
IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOL FUNDING FORMULA.

WHEREAS, the concept of a cost-of-living factor in the distribution of public school funds is not new among state school funding systems, and six states currently adjust for cost differentials in their school districts; and

WHEREAS, living costs vary throughout New Mexico because New Mexico's eighty-nine school districts are located in isolated rural settings, populous urban communities and small-to medium-sized communities throughout the state; and

WHEREAS, numerous models can be devised to evaluate the cost of living in various communities; and

WHEREAS, there are no available cost-of-living data for the

state's eighty-nine school districts that would allow the easy calculation of an objective, verifiable factor for incorporation into the public school funding formula; and

WHEREAS, many people believe that the cost of living in a community can be a barrier to attracting, hiring and retaining quality teachers, thus creating a major obstacle to providing students a high quality education; and

WHEREAS, the effect of providing a cost-of-living factor in some urban areas may make it difficult to attract and retain teachers in rural isolated areas because high-cost-of-living areas can pay higher salaries and offer amenities to their teachers and other school personnel; and

WHEREAS, other variables that exist, such as the availability of medical and other services, desirability of location and conditions of employment, affect a district's ability to attract and retain quality personnel;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO request the legislative education study committee, in cooperation with the state department of public education and school districts, to perform or contract for a comprehensive study to determine the relationship between higher living costs and the specific costs of education; to examine the various issues and costs that affect a school district's ability to attract and retain quality teachers and school personnel; to determine if there are cost-of-living differences that result in

differences in a district's resources to educate its students; to establish a database comparing school district expenditures and to conduct a cost survey that includes questions about food, consumer durables, medical costs, insurance, housing and other variables relative to all geographic areas in the state that may provide information to determine living costs; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the study examine the ways in which such data can be collected and updated on a regular basis and the costs associated with such collection: and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the study be completed by November 1, 1997 and that the legislative education study committee submit its report and recommendations to the second session of the forty-third legislature; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be transmitted to the director of the legislative education study committee staff for appropriate distribution.
