A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE GOVERNOR TO APPOINT A TASK FORCE TO CONSIDER  
ACTIONS TO CORRECT PROBLEMS ASSOCIATED WITH REIMBURSEMENT OF  
SERVICE PROVIDERS BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, THE HUMAN  
SERVICES DEPARTMENT AND THE CHILDREN, YOUTH AND FAMILIES  
DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, much of the business of the state is accomplished  
by private entrepreneurs, vendors and contractors; and

WHEREAS, when the state receives services rendered by  
private business pursuant to a purchase agreement or contract  
for services it is legally and morally incumbent upon the state  
to pay its bills; and

WHEREAS, private businesses depend on customers and clients  
to pay their bills or those private businesses providing  
products and services to the state may be faced with credit

1 claims being pressed against them or even forced into  
2 bankruptcy; and

3 WHEREAS, businesses and private individuals must pay their  
4 bills or be subject to legal action; and

5 WHEREAS, many of the businesses that provide services to  
6 the department of health, the human services department and the  
7 children, youth and families department have not been paid for  
8 their services, sometimes carrying debts by the state for as  
9 long as two years; and

10 WHEREAS, repeated efforts by service contractors and  
11 vendors to obtain payment from the state for their services have  
12 failed;

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE  
14 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the governor be requested to form a  
15 task force to determine the source of the problems of unpaid  
16 bills of the state and correct those problems, making the  
17 necessary payments for unreimbursed claims against the state;  
18 and

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the secretaries of finance and  
20 administration, health, human services and children, youth and  
21 families be directed by the governor to cooperate with the small  
22 business community, state vendors and contractors, service  
23 providers and provider associations to pay the state's bills;  
24 and

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force report its
