#### **SENATE JOINT MEMORIAL 11** 43RD LEGISLATURE - STATE OF NEW MEXICO - FIRST SESSION, 1997 INTRODUCED BY CARLOS R. CISNEROS A JOINT MEMORIAL REQUESTING THE STATE ENGINEER TO DEVELOP AND MAINTAIN A WATER BUDGET FOR THE STATE.

WHEREAS, the state engineer is responsible for the measurement and appropriation of the scarce water resources of New Mexico and of their distribution among an increasing number

of water users, in the context of interstate stream compact  $% \left( 1\right) =\left( 1\right) \left( 1\right)$ 

deliveries that must be maintained; and

WHEREAS, data on usage and long-term sustainability of the resource are crucial in deciding basin adjudications and acting on water rights applications; and

WHEREAS, additional information on water use and water supply is sorely needed to assist in adjudicating rights along the Rio Grande, the most heavily appropriated river and ground water basin in the state; and

WHEREAS, the state's water budget depends completely on water yields generated by healthy mountain forests and land; and

WHEREAS, the potential to increase water yield of the state's watersheds through land use, forest and range management has received little research and less action; and

WHEREAS, additional water use data would bolster efforts at water conservation and assist in preventing over-diversion; and

WHEREAS, water planning efforts now under way in many regions of the state would be enhanced by improved information on water use and water resources;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the office of the state engineer be requested to compile the data necessary to construct a water budget for every stream system and declared basin in the state, beginning with those under the greatest pressure from water users and interstate stream compact requirements; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the state engineer be requested to, at a minimum, meter or take other measurements of all permitted water uses and return flows, and develop data management system to permit accurate storage, rapid retrieval and flexible analysis surface of the water use records; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the state engineer be requested to conduct research and monitoring efforts to quantify surface and ground water resources and water yield by watershed; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the state engineer be provided

the support to carry out a needs assessment within his office and report back to the legislature by December 1, 1997 with a phasing plan and cost estimate for developing the information base described above; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be transmitted to the state engineer.
