15	WHEREAS, during the past decade, an increasingly diverse
16	population of students has sought post-secondary education,
17	resulting in demand for more flexible access to instruction and
18	a greater array of support services; and
19	WHEREAS, during the past decade, demand for post-secondary
20	education has expanded to encompass new fields of study, to
21	accommodate new areas of employment and to provide advanced
22	training and retraining for citizens already in the work force;
23	and
24	WHEREAS, rapidly changing technologies have expanded the
25	options for delivery of instruction, achievement of learning and

assessment of performance; and

WHEREAS, during the past decade, costs of post-secondary education appear to have increased at rates higher than other services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the commission on higher education be asked to undertake a long-term program of evaluation and planning with the goal of assuring the availability of highquality post-secondary education delivered efficiently throughout the state and responsive to the needs of New Mexico's citizenry and the demands of the twenty-first century; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the commission be asked to consult with state post-secondary institutions and with representatives of private post-secondary education, public education, employers, Native American tribal leaders and other sectors of the citizenry, as appropriate, in the initiation and conduct of this program; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in order to accomplish this evaluation and planning collaboratively and without expansion of the state government, state post-secondary institutions be asked to support the commission by providing technical assistance and contributing staff support to the commission, as requested by the commission; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the commission be encouraged to include in this program of evaluation and planning analyses of

quality and productivity of educational programs offered by state post-secondary institutions; operating costs and efficiencies of the institutions and their educational programs; congruity or discongruity between existing educational programs and current state needs; and methods for improving the delivery of state support, including performance-based funding; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that as an outcome of this program of evaluation and planning the commission be encouraged to identify optimal levels and methods of funding for postsecondary education; appropriate shares of the cost of postsecondary education; and appropriate means for managing costs and improving efficiency without sacrificing quality of postsecondary education; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the commission be asked to report annually to the legislature and the governor on the status and progress of this program, including any recommendations for legislation, beginning in January 1998; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be transmitted to the executive director of the commission on higher education for circulation to all state post-secondary institutions.
