A J OINT MEMORIAL
REQUESTING THE MOTOR VEHICLE DIVISION OF THE TAXATION AND REVENUE DEPARTMENT TO ESTABLISH A FIELD OFFICE IN THE SOUTHWEST QUADRANT OF THE ALBUQUERQUE METROPOLITAN AREA.

WHEREAS, the south valley is a conglomeration of historic native New Mexican communities that include Atrisco, Armijo, Five Points, Pajarito and Los Padillas in which reside about sixty-eight thousand people; and

WHEREAS, the oldest community in the area, Atrisco, was established in 1692 and is older than old town Al buquerque; and

WHEREAS, with such a continuous history and I arge
population, it is incumbent upon the state to provide adequate facilities for the residents to comply with the state's laws such as vehicle registration; and

WHEREAS, the nearest motor vehicle division office is
fifteen miles from the average resident of the area; and WHEREAS, a $\operatorname{local}$ service office in the area would reduce traffic congestion, air pollution and the risk of accidents by the elderly living in the communities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE State of New mexico that the motor vehicle division of the taxation and revenue department be requested to establish a field office in the southwest quadrant of the Albuquerque metropolitan area; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the secretary of taxation and revenue and to the director of the motor vehicle division.
