WHEREAS, with a competitive electric industry,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the New Mexico public utility commi ssion be requested to establish a consumer and environmental interests monitoring section to oversee and evaluate the impacts and benefits resulting from the restructuring of the electric industry and ensure that negative i mpacts to consumers or to environmental interests be mitigated and that benefits to consumers and the environment be preserved and enhanced; and
