A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THAT THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC EDUCATION BE
REQUESTED TO STUDY THE ADMINISTRATIVE STRUCTURE, FUNDING
STREAMS, PROGRAM DELIVERY AND DATA COLLECTION METHODS OF ADULT
BASIC EDUCATION PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS, New Mexico's adult basic education programs are important for addressing the state's illiteracy problems; and

WHEREAS, New Mexico's adult basic education programs serve almost thirty-seven thousand of our citizens, but the estimated need is in excess of two hundred seventy thousand; and

WHEREAS, New Mexico's adult basic education classes are offered primarily through the state's system of community colleges at two hundred sixty-six sites statewide, but there still remains unequal access to rural populations; and

WHEREAS, New Mexico's adult basic education program is

expected to play an increasing role in the transition of our citizens from welfare and the transition of special needs students into the workplace or post-secondary education, creating additional demands on services; and

WHEREAS, a new, more equitable funding formula for distribution has been developed as a result of the adult basic education working group, comprised of institutional fiscal agents, but state dollars may not be available for full implementation; and

WHEREAS, the continued success of New Mexico's adult basic education program is linked to program expansion, instructional and program innovations, development of measurable and meaningful outcomes, strong working relationships with other agencies that serve adult basic education clients and increased meaningful linkages with employers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the state department of public education be requested to study the administrative structure, funding streams, program delivery and data collection methods of the adult basic education program with participation of the commission on higher education, community colleges and other administrative sites and other agencies involved in the administration of adult basic education and literacy programs; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the state department of public

education make recommendations about expanded service, serving needs of rural and special populations, increased instructional quality, development of data collection strategies and accountability measures, efficient management and coordination of services and identification of funding support and needs and report to the appropriate interim committee of the legislature by December 1, 1997; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the superintendent of public instruction and the commission on higher education.
