A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THAT THE REVENUE STABILIZATION AND TAX POLICY
COMMITTEE STUDY MATTERS RELATED TO REGULATION OF
TELECOMMUNICATIONS IN NEW MEXICO AND REPORT ITS FINDINGS AND
RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE SECOND SESSION OF THE FORTY-THIRD
LEGISLATURE.

WHEREAS, the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 establishes new standards governing this nation's telecommunications industry and will open all segments of the industry to competition; and

WHEREAS, the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 requires that state regulation of telecommunications companies or services be consistent with that federal act; and

WHEREAS, the state corporation commission has conducted numerous public forums, formal hearings and studies and has

promulgated new rules consistent with the federal act, including issuing competitive certificates to new entrants into New Mexico telecommunications markets; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to approval of Constitutional Amendment 6 by the electorate of New Mexico at the 1996 general election, the state corporation commission and the New Mexico public utility commission are to be merged into a new public regulation commission, and this means that new telecommunications laws may need to be enacted; and

WHEREAS, these major changes in regulation of telecommunications mean the legislature is faced with complex regulatory issues that must be addressed and understood if legislation that is in the best interest of New Mexicans is to be crafted and enacted into law:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that it request that the New Mexico legislative council direct the revenue stabilization and tax policy committee to study matters dealing with regulation of the telecommunications industry and the regulatory authority governing that industry in New Mexico; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the revenue stabilization and tax policy committee coordinate its study with any other legislative interim committee or task force that has been directed to study similar public regulatory issues; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the revenue stabilization and

tax policy committee report its findings and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the second session of the forty-third legislature; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be given to the speaker of the house of representatives, the president pro tempore of the senate and each member of the state corporation commission.
