A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE NEW MEXICO LEGISLATURE TO SUPPORT THE NAVAJO

AGRICULTURAL PRODUCT INDUSTRIES TO BECOME A FOOD VENDOR FOR THE

UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE.

WHEREAS, the Navajo nation food distribution program supports the Navajo agricultural product industries as a United States department of agriculture commodity food vendor; and

WHEREAS, Navajo agricultural product industries is an Indian-owned enterprise that is capable of harvesting pinto beans for the United States department of agriculture; and

WHEREAS, the Navajo nation food distribution program supports Navajo agricultural product industries' harvesting its own pinto beans for the United States department of agriculture so they can be used by Navajo nation food distribution program clients; and

WHEREAS, the Navajo nation food distribution program wants to improve the dietary habits among households in the Navajo nation utilizing United States department of agriculture commodity food; and

WHEREAS, in April 1996, a food preference survey conducted by the Navajo nation food distribution program revealed that eighty-one percent of its clients favor pinto beans and want them added to the United States department of agriculture commodity food list; and

WHEREAS, the Navajo nation food distribution program would like to be receiving Navajo agricultural product industries' pinto beans in 1997; and

WHEREAS, the Navajo nation food distribution program working with Navajo agricultural products industries and the United States department of agriculture will help the Navajo nation's people and its economy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that it support Navajo agricultural products industries to become a food vendor for the United States department of agriculture; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the speaker of the house of representatives, the president pro tempore of the senate and the president of the Navajo nation.
