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15	WHEREAS, infrastructure is a vital link in the economic	
16	development master plan for New Mexico; and	
17	WHEREAS, the senate is committed to advancing the state's	
18	economic development prospects by improving the state's highway	
19	and transportation system; and	
20	WHEREAS, the state highway and transportation department's funds	
21	may be available in fiscal year 1998 to meet these needs; and	
22	WHEREAS, the reauthorization of federal highway funding pursuant	
23	to the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act of 1991	
24	will result in approximately one billion one hundred million	
25	dollars (\$1,100,000,000) in federal highway funds for New	

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Mexico; and

WHEREAS, this substantial increase represents seventy million dollars (\$70,000,000) to eighty-five million dollars (\$85,000,000) more of federal highway funds annually available to New Mexico for a period of time; and WHEREAS, the projects listed below are to be regarded with equal priority; and

WHEREAS, local governments must participate with at least ten percent of the costs enumerated within this memorial and these projects are contingent upon local governments obtaining the required rights of way for the specified projects enumerated in this memorial and upon all projects being under contract by the end of fiscal year 1997; and

WHEREAS, the projects are as follows:

A. in San Juan county:

- (1) seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) for parking lot and road improvements at Mesa elementary school;
- sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) for improvement of threetenths of a mile of the Mesa Farm road and school bus route;
- fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for road improvements near Tse-Bit'ai junior high and middle school; (4) one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for improvement of one-half mile of road near Nizhoni elementary school;
 - six hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$650,000) for **(5)** engineering and right-of-way acquisition for twelve and six-

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tenths miles of school bus route on N-69;

- six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) for engineering and **(6)** right-of-way acquisition on N-5000 from Sanostee to Toadlena;
- six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) for engineering and right-of-way acquisition on N-5010 from Sanostee to Toadlena;
 - **(8)** three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to replace two bridges near Crystal on SR 134 to N-112;
- **(9)** three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for engineering and right-of-way acquisition for school bus routes near Crystal on SR-134;
 - sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) for engineering and (10)right-of-way acquisition on N-5112 near Beclabito school;
 - one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for engineering and right-of-way acquisition on N-469 near Indian village;
- (12)four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) for improvements to the school bus loop near Naschitti;
- (13)fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for engineering, design and right-of-way acquisition on N-5031 near Hogback;
- (14)eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000) for twenty-two miles of right-of-way acquisition on N-5 near the Burnham chapter; and eight hundred thousand dollars (\$800,000) for engineering, design and right-of-way acquisition on N-5113 also known as the Beclabito school bus route; and
 - В. in Sandoval county: five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for school bus route improvements on N-46 near

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Lybrook; and

C. in McKinley county:

- (1) fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for overpass engineering on N-566 on the Church Rock interchange over interstate 40;
- (2) seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) for right-of-way acquisition and environmental assessment on N-69A from White Rock to US 666;
- (3) eight hundred thousand dollars (\$800,000) for sixteen miles of engineering from N-9 to SR 566;
- (4) two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for engineering and right-of-way acquisition on four and two-tenths miles of N-7113 from Peshlakai road to Mariano lake;
 - (5) two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for engineering and right-of-way acquisition on N-9652 from Lake valley to SR 371;
- (6) seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) for archaeological surveys and environmental assessments for various roads on the Navajo nation;
 - (7) four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) for school bus route improvements between Coyote canyon and Twin lakes;
- (8) four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) for improvements for McKinley county road number 1 between Tsyatoh and Blackhead; and
 - (9) four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) for road improvements southeast of Pinedale;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE

OF NEW MEXICO that the state highway and transportation
department be directed to utilize unexpended funds from the
state road fund in fiscal year 1998 in the above-described

manner for the purposes listed herein; and
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be sent to
the secretary of highway and transportation, the governor, the
speaker of the house of representatives and the president pro
tempore of the senate.
