WHEREAS, there has been little effort undertaken by the state department of public education and the office of cultural affairs to determine what educational technology resources should be made available to students in Native American schools and libraries; and

WHEREAS, there is little question that Native American students need and deserve these educational technology resources in their schools and libraries;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the state department of public education, the office of cultural affairs and Native American tribal representatives work jointly in developing a plan that will obtain and coordinate educational technology resources for public schools and libraries located in Native American tribal districts and communities; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the state department of public education, the office of cultural affairs and Native American tribal representatives report their findings to the legislative education study committee by September 30, 1997; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the superintendent of public instruction, the
