15	WHEREAS, more than one hundred forty million dollars
16	(\$140,000,000) in state and federal funds are administered by
17	the department of health and the human services department to
18	assist people with developmental disabilities and their families
19	to receive the support and services they need; and
20	WHEREAS, there are approximately eighteen thousand eligible
21	people with developmental disabilities on waiting lists for
22	these services; and
23	WHEREAS, the interests of the people of the state,
24	including people with developmental disabilities and their
25	families, are best served when programs are effective, efficient

and consistent with the public policy expressed in the laws of New Mexico and the United States; and

WHEREAS, the needs of people with developmental disabilities and their families vary;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the department of health convene a task force that includes people with disabilities and their families, members of advocacy organizations, providers of services and support and other state agencies with responsibilities for services for people with developmental disabilities and their families to study the effectiveness and efficiency of funding mechanisms and providers of services and support and to make recommendations to the department of health, other state agencies and the legislature on improving effectiveness, efficiency and access to services, consistent with the public policy expressed in the laws of New Mexico and the United States; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the study include the following:

A. the ratio between direct service cost and administrative costs at the state and provider levels;

B. the purchase and use of real estate by providers;

C. the relationship among the needs of people receiving services, consumer and family choice and program costs;
