**MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO FUND A NATIVE AMERICAN SUBSTANCE
ABUSE PREVENTION AND COMMUNITY WELLNESS PROGRAM**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

**Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --Two hundred ninety-five
thousand dollars (\$295,000) is appropriated from the general
fund to the New Mexico office of Indian affairs for
expenditure in fiscal year 1999 for the purpose of contracting
to provide substance abuse and wellness retreats for young
people in Shiprock located in San Juan county. Any unexpended
or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year
1999 shall revert to the general fund.**
