FOR THE INDIAN AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO CONTRACT FOR PROVISION OF SERVICES
FOR VICTIMS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE WITH A SHELTER THAT USES
TRADITIONAL NATIVE AMERICAN THERAPY TECHNIQUES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the department of health for expenditure in fiscal year 1999 for the purpose of contracting for provision of services for victims of domestic violence with a domestic violence shelter that uses Native American traditional healing and counseling techniques to be located in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the general fund.
