AN ACT

**RELATING TO EDUCATION; PROVIDING FOR THE COORDINATION AND
ADMINISTRATION OF EXTENDED LEARNING PROGRAMS BY THE COMMISSION
ON HIGHER EDUCATION; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

**Section 1. OFFICE OF EXTENDED LEARNING CREATED--
COMMISSION ON HIGHER EDUCATION-- DUTIES. --**

**A. The "office of extended learning" is created in
the commission on higher education. The office of extended
learning shall coordinate extended learning programs of the
post-secondary educational institutions.**

B. The office of extended learning shall:

**(1) coordinate the provision of resources for
extended learning services among public post-secondary
institutions to ensure access, efficiency and accountability**

2 programs;

3 (2) coordinate and review the development of
4 the technology-based extended learning delivery system that
5 augments the existing infrastructure, avoids unnecessary
6 duplication of and incompatibility with the existing system
7 and provides statewide access to high quality extended
8 learning;

9 (3) develop accountability measures used by
10 the post-secondary educational institutions to take place
11 within two years that include:

- 12 (a) delivery costs;
- 13 (b) access;
- 14 (c) market demand;
- 15 (d) program quality and effectiveness;
- 16 (e) public relations;
- 17 (f) professional development;
- 18 (g) technical reliability; and
- 19 (h) student satisfaction;

20 (4) collaborate with secondary schools in the
21 development of extended learning education opportunities to
22 students statewide;

23 (5) encourage the participation, cooperation
24 and collaboration of public educational institutions, private
25 institutions and other public entities statewide to share

1 resources and expertise in the development of a comprehensive
2 and interconnected statewide extended learning system; and

3 (6) make appropriate adjustments in the
4 funding formula to accommodate a statewide extended learning
5 system.

6 Section 2. APPROPRIATION. -- Three million six hundred
7 thousand dollars (\$3,600,000) is appropriated from the general
8 fund to the commission on higher education for expenditure in
9 fiscal year 1999 to be divided according to their costs among
10 originating, transmitting and receiving institutions for
11 extended learning services statewide. Any unexpended or
12 unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999
13 shall revert to the general fund.

14 Section 3. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred thousand dollars
15 (\$100,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
16 commission on higher education for expenditure in fiscal year
17 1999 for the purpose of establishing an office of and
18 coordinating a statewide system of extended learning. Any
19 unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of
20 fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the general fund.
