AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE OPERATIONAL EXPENSES OF EXTENDED  
LEARNING PROGRAMS AND EXTENDED LEARNING LIBRARY SERVICES  
STATEWIDE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATIONS. --

A. The following amounts are appropriated from the  
general fund to the respective agencies for expenditure in  
fiscal year 1999 for the following purposes:

(1) one hundred fifty-seven thousand eight  
hundred twenty dollars (\$157,820) to the board of regents of  
northern New Mexico state school to operate the extended  
learning network in northern New Mexico;

(2) two hundred fifteen thousand thirty-nine  
dollars (\$215,039) to the board of regents of western New

1 Mexico university to operate extended learning facilities and  
2 services in Catron, Grant, Hidalgo, Luna and Sierra counties;

3 (3) one hundred forty-one thousand four  
4 hundred seventy dollars (\$141,470) to the board of regents of  
5 New Mexico state university to operate the university's  
6 extended learning facilities in Otero county;

7 (4) two hundred fifty-four thousand eight  
8 hundred fifty dollars (\$254,850) to the board of regents of  
9 the university of New Mexico to purchase statewide electronic  
10 library equipment and materials to support extended learning  
11 resources and facilities for the members of the New Mexico  
12 consortium of academic libraries; and

13 (5) thirty-seven thousand six hundred forty  
14 dollars (\$37,640) to the board of regents of New Mexico state  
15 university to purchase and install equipment for and provide  
16 extended learning courses to the Navajo nation for the masters  
17 in social work program in McKinley and San Juan counties.

18 B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance  
19 remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the  
20 general fund.
