AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION; CREATING THE EXTENDED LEARNING STUDY
COMMITTEE; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. EXTENDED LEARNING STUDY COMMITTEE. --

A. The "extended learning study committee" is
created. The committee shall consist of:

(1) the chairmen of the commission on higher
education and the state board of education or their designees,
who shall serve as co-chairmen of the committee;

(2) one representative from the New Mexico
association of community colleges;

(3) one representative from the public four-
year institutions appointed by the council of presidents;

(4) the state librarian;

1 (5) the superintendent of public instruction;

2 (6) two representatives appointed by the
3 governor from the communications industry;

4 (7) two representatives from the business
5 community, one appointed by the speaker of the house of
6 representatives and one appointed by the president pro tempore
7 of the senate;

8 (8) one representative from the national
9 guard of New Mexico;

10 (9) the chief information officer;

11 (10) one representative from the associated
12 students of the universities of New Mexico; and

13 (11) one representative from the
14 superintendents association.

15 B. The committee shall advise the commission on
16 higher education and public post-secondary educational
17 institutions on the development of a plan to establish an
18 extended learning network that may include public and private
19 educational institutions, libraries, medical facilities,
20 existing virtual universities, other public facilities and
21 private sector entities that donate their facilities and
22 resources for extended learning services.

23 C. The committee shall develop an extended
24 learning plan that includes a timetable with phase-in options,
25 cost projections, strategies for addressing professional

1 development needs and recommendations to the legislature and
2 the governor for implementing the plan.

3 D. The commission on higher education and the
4 state board of education shall jointly provide staff support
5 and administrative services to the committee.

6 E. The committee shall report its findings and
7 recommendations to the governor and to the legislature by
8 December 1, 1998.

9 F. Members of the extended learning study
10 committee who are not state employees shall be paid per diem
11 and mileage as provided in the Per Diem and Mileage Act and
12 shall receive no other compensation, perquisite or allowance.

13 Section 2. APPROPRIATION. -- Fifty thousand dollars
14 (\$50,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
15 commission on higher education for expenditure in fiscal years
16 1998 and 1999 for the purpose of supporting the work of the
17 extended learning study committee. Any unexpended or
18 unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999
19 shall revert to the general fund.

20 Section 3. EMERGENCY. -- It is necessary for the public
21 peace, health and safety that this act take effect
22 immediately.
