AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR AN ORPHAN SITES TECHNOLOGY
DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM AT NEW MEXICO STATE UNIVERSITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Four hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$450,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of New Mexico state university for expenditure in fiscal year 1999 for the purpose of creating an orphan sites technology development program. The program will establish a testing, verification and ranking system for selection and application of new technologies for reduction, remediation and prevention of nitrate contamination. The program will be implemented by the waste-management education and research consortium, administratively located at New Mexico state university. Any unexpended or unencumbered
