BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the local government division of the department of finance and administration for expenditure in fiscal year 1999 for the purpose of contracting for services with the Albuquerque department of family and community services for residential services and job training for women leaving the Bernalillo county detention center. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the general fund.
