AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES FOR YOUTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Five million two hundred thousand dollars (\$5,200,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the children, youth and families department for expenditure in fiscal year 1999 for the purpose of providing behavioral health services for youth who are involved or are at risk of involvement with the juvenile justice system and who have been denied behavioral health services through the federal medicaid program. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the general fund.
