AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE CRIMINAL AND JUVENILE JUSTICE COORDINATING COUNCIL FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONDUCTING A STUDY OF ISSUES RELATED TO CAPITAL FELONY CASES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the criminal and juvenile justice coordinating council for expenditure in fiscal year 1999 for the purpose of conducting a study of issues, including sentencing policies, related to capital felony cases in New Mexico. The council shall report its findings to an interim legislative committee with jurisdiction over criminal law issues no later than October 31, 1998. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the general fund.
