BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the office of the state engineer for expenditure in fiscal year 1999 for the purpose of funding a watermaster to enforce the settlement between tribal and nontribal users on the Rio Jemez. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the general fund.
