AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO PROVIDE TOURISM DEVELOPMENT
SERVICES TO ALL TRIBES IN NEW MEXICO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the tourism department for expenditure in fiscal year 1999 for the purpose of contracting with an organization that aids Indian nations, tribes and pueblos in the development of culturally appropriate economic development opportunities related to tourism for Indian tribes. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the general fund.
