MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE CHILDREN, YOUTH AND FAMILIES
DEPARTMENT FOR ADDITIONAL CLIENT HOME SERVICE AGENTS TO
PREVENT INSTITUTIONALIZATION OF CERTAIN PERSONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the children, youth and families department for expenditure in fiscal year 1999 for the purpose of hiring a minimum of ten new full-time-equivalent client home-service agents to perform basic household maintenance and chores for certain homebound individuals who might otherwise be forced to reside in institutions. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the general fund.
