AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO FUND PROGRAM SUPPORT FOR PERSONS
WITH HUMAN IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Two million dollars
(\$2,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
department of health for expenditure in fiscal year 1999 for
the purpose of funding programs for persons with human
immunodeficiency virus, including medications, clinical
treatment and support services, insurance assistance, Native
American case management and traditional medicine, prevention
programs, provider education programs and counseling and
testing. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at
the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the general fund.
