17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
18	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSAUTHORIZATIONS
19	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS
20	A. The state board of finance may issue and sell
21	severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax
22	Bonding Act in an amount not to exceed the total of the
23	amounts authorized for purposes specified in this act. The
24	state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of
25	the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner

possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. Proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated for the purposes specified in this act.

B. The agencies named in this act shall certify to the state board of finance when the money from the proceeds of the severance tax bonds authorized in this section is needed for the purposes specified in the applicable section of this act.

C. If the specified agency has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 2000, the authorization provided in this act shall be void.

D. Unless otherwise specified in this act, any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining from the proceeds of severance tax bonds issued pursuant to this act at the end of fiscal year 2002 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund.
