AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO COMBAT HOMELESSNESS IN FARMINGTON.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred fifty-five thousand dollars (\$155,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the New Mexico office of Indian affairs for expenditure in fiscal year 1999 for the purpose of contracting for provision of culturally appropriate services to combat homelessness and its causes among Native Americans in Farmington in San Juan county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the general fund.
