AN ACT

**RELATING TO EDUCATION; CREATING THE EDUCATIONAL RADIO
EQUIPMENT REPLACEMENT FUND; PROVIDING FOR ITS DISBURSEMENT;
MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. EDUCATIONAL RADIO EQUIPMENT REPLACEMENT

**FUND--CREATED.--The "educational radio equipment replacement
fund" is created in the state treasury. Money in the fund is
appropriated to the office on information and communication
management. The office on information and communication
management shall administer the fund and promulgate rules for
the disbursement of the money in the fund, based on criteria
developed by the New Mexico commission on public broadcasting,
for the replacement of equipment at educational radio stations
operated by public post-secondary educational institutions,**

1 public school districts or Indian nations, tribes or pueblos
2 located in New Mexico. Disbursements shall be made by warrant
3 of the department of finance and administration upon vouchers
4 signed by the chief information officer of the office on
5 information and communication management. Money in the fund
6 shall not revert to the general fund at the end of a fiscal
7 year.

8 Section 2. APPROPRIATION. -- Seventy-five thousand dollars
9 (\$75,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
10 educational radio equipment replacement fund for expenditure
11 in fiscal year 1999 and subsequent fiscal years for the
12 replacement of educational radio equipment in accordance with
13 the provisions of Section 1 of this act. Any unexpended or
14 unencumbered balance remaining at the end of any fiscal year
15 shall not revert to the general fund.
