AN ACT

**MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO PROVIDE FOR TOURISM DEVELOPMENT
ASSESSMENTS AND PLANS FOR FIFTY NAVAJO CHAPTERS IN NEW MEXICO.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

**Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Three hundred thousand
dollars (\$300,000) is appropriated from the general fund to
the New Mexico office of Indian affairs for expenditure in
fiscal year 1999 for the purpose of contracting for the
creation of tourism development assessments and plans for
fifty Navajo chapters located in New Mexico. Any unexpended
or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year
1999 shall revert to the general fund.**
