MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE CHILDREN, YOUTH AND FAMILIES DEPARTMENT TO PROVIDE SERVICES TO CHILDREN NOT ELIGIBLE FOR MEDICAID.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Seven million dollars (\$7,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the children, youth and families department for expenditure in fiscal year 1999 to provide services, including counseling, after school programming, life skills, mentoring, home-based services, individual and family therapy, behavioral management and substance abuse treatment for children not eligible for medicaid. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the general fund. . 120081.1
