**Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Eighty-seven thousand dollars  
(\$87,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state  
department of public education for expenditure in fiscal year  
1999 for the purpose of funding one-time salary increases for  
national-board-certified instructional staff for services  
currently rendered. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance  
remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the  
general fund.**
