AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH; ELIMINATING THE COORDINATED TREATMENT
PANEL; CHANGING THE ADMISSION AND TREATMENT CRITERIA AT THE
ADOLESCENT TREATMENT HOSPITAL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 23-9-2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1992,
Chapter 60, Section 2) is amended to read:

"23-9-2. DEFINITIONS. -- As used in the Adolescent
Treatment Hospital Act:

A. "adolescent" means a person aged thirteen
through twenty;

B. "adolescent treatment hospital" means the
hospital created pursuant to the Adolescent Treatment Hospital
Act;

C. "board" means the adolescent treatment hospital

2 D. "adolescent residential treatment facility"
3 means the facility created pursuant to the Adolescent
4 Treatment Hospital Act; and

5 ~~[E. "coordinated treatment panel" means the group~~

13 Section 2. Section 23-9-6 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1992,
14 Chapter 60, Section 6) is amended to read:

15 "23-9-6. HOSPITAL ADMISSIONS--TREATMENT. --

16 A. Adolescents shall be admitted to the adolescent
17 treatment hospital and adolescent residential treatment
18 facility only in accordance with the provisions of the Mental
19 Health and Developmental Disabilities Code [~~and pursuant to~~
20 ~~the recommendations of the coordinated treatment panel~~] or the
21 Children's Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities Act .

22 B. The secretary shall, in consultation with the
23 board, define admittance criteria; provided that the criteria
24 may not exclude adolescents in the custody of other agencies
25 who might otherwise meet the criteria for services provided

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1 through the adolescent treatment hospital.

2 C. The Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities
3 Code or the Children's Mental Health and Developmental
4 Disabilities Act shall apply to inpatient treatment."
