AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE RECORDS; AMENDING A SECTION OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLE CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 66-2-7.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1995,
Chapter 135, Section 4) is amended to read:

"66-2-7.1. MOTOR VEHICLE-RELATED RECORDS--CONFIDENTIAL.--

A. It is unlawful for any department employee or
contractor or for any former department employee or contractor
to disclose to any person other than another employee of the
department any personal information about an individual
obtained by the department in connection with a driver's
license or permit, the titling or registration of a vehicle or
an identification card issued by the department pursuant to the
Motor Vehicle Code except:

2 authorized representative;

3 (2) for use by any governmental agency,
4 including any court, in carrying out its functions or by any
5 private person acting on behalf of the government;

6 (3) for use in connection with matters of
7 motor vehicle and driver safety or theft; motor vehicle
8 emissions; performance monitoring of motor vehicles, motor
9 vehicle parts and dealers; motor vehicle market research
10 activities, including survey research; motor vehicle
11 production alterations, recalls or advisories and removal of
12 non-owner records from original owner records of motor vehicle
13 manufacturers;

14 (4) for use in research activities and for
15 use in producing statistical reports so long as the personal
16 information is not published, redisclosed or used to contact
17 individuals;

18 (5) for use by any insurer or insurance
19 support organization or by a self-insured entity or its
20 agents, employees or contractors in connection with claims
21 investigation activities, antifraud activities, rating or
22 underwriting;

23 (6) for providing notice to owners of towed
24 or impounded vehicles;

25 (7) for use by an employer or its agent or

2 holder of a commercial driver's license;

3 (8) for use by any requester if the requester
4 demonstrates that it has obtained the written consent of the
5 individual to whom the information pertains; [or]

6 (9) for any use in response to requests for
7 individual motor vehicle records if the department has
8 provided in a clear and conspicuous manner on forms for
9 issuance or renewal of operator's permits, titles,
10 registrations or identification cards notice that personal
11 information collected by the department may be disclosed to
12 any person and the department has provided in a clear and
13 conspicuous manner on such forms an opportunity to prohibit
14 such disclosures; or

15 (10) for use by an insured state-chartered or
16 federally chartered credit union; an insured state or national
17 bank; an insured state or federal savings and loan association
18 or insured savings bank; or any of their agents, employees or
19 contractors, but only:

20 (a) to verify the accuracy of personal
21 information submitted by an individual to the credit union,
22 bank, savings and loan association or savings bank; and

23 (b) if the information as submitted is
24 not correct or is no longer correct, to obtain the correct
25 information, but only for the purpose of preventing fraud by,

pursuing legal remedies against or recovering on a debt or security interest from the individual.

B. Any person who violates the provisions of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction [thereof] shall be punished in accordance with the provisions of Section 31-19-1 NMSA 1978. "
