AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO STATE PUBLIC POST-SECONDARY
INSTITUTIONS FOR ENHANCEMENT OF THE FUNDING FORMULA FOR
EXTENDED SERVICES INSTRUCTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATIONS. --

A. Seven hundred sixty-seven thousand seven
hundred dollars (\$767,700) is appropriated from the general
fund to the following public post-secondary institutions for
expenditure in fiscal year 1999 for the purpose of reducing
the tuition credit in the funding formula for extended
services instruction:

(1) two thousand one hundred dollars (\$2,100)
to the board of regents of New Mexico institute of mining and
technology in Socorro county;

1 (2) eighty-one thousand four hundred dollars
2 (\$81,400) to the board of regents of New Mexico state
3 university in Dona Ana county;

4 (3) four hundred one thousand six hundred
5 dollars (\$401,600) to the board of regents of the university
6 of New Mexico in Bernalillo county;

7 (4) seventy-five thousand one hundred dollars
8 (\$75,100) to the board of regents of eastern New Mexico
9 university in Roosevelt county;

10 (5) sixty thousand eight hundred dollars
11 (\$60,800) to the board of regents of New Mexico highlands
12 university in San Miguel county;

13 (6) eighty-one thousand dollars (\$81,000) to
14 the board of regents of western New Mexico university in Grant
15 county;

16 (7) sixteen thousand six hundred dollars
17 (\$16,600) to the governing board of Clovis community college
18 in Curry county;

19 (8) seven thousand three hundred dollars
20 (\$7,300) to the governing board of New Mexico junior college
21 in Lea county;

22 (9) nine thousand seven hundred dollars
23 (\$9,700) to the board of regents of northern New Mexico state
24 school in Rio Arriba county; and

25 (10) thirty-two thousand one hundred dollars

1 (\$32,100) to the board of regents of the Roswell branch of
2 eastern New Mexico university in Chaves county.

3 B. Two million six hundred fifty thousand one
4 hundred dollars (\$2,650,100) is appropriated from the general
5 fund to the commission on higher education for expenditure in
6 fiscal year 1999 for the purpose of funding the general or "G"
7 component of the extended services and distance education
8 formula. In order to encourage collaboration between the
9 institutions delivering instructional credit and those at
10 which the credit is received, the delivering and receiving
11 institutions, in cooperation with the commission on higher
12 education, shall devise a plan for distribution of this
13 funding between the delivering and receiving institutions on
14 an equitable basis. Funds shall be distributed to the
15 institutions by the commission on higher education upon
16 completion of this funding distribution plan.

17 C. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance
18 remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the
19 general fund.
