AN ACT

RELATING TO POST-SECONDARY EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION FUNDING;  
AMENDING THE POST-SECONDARY EDUCATIONAL PLANNING ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 21-2-2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1973,  
Chapter 233, Section 2) is amended to read:

"21-2-2. DEFINITIONS. -- As used in the Post-Secondary  
Educational Planning Act:

A. "post-secondary education":

(1) means education, training or retraining  
for persons sixteen years of age or older who have graduated  
from secondary school or left elementary or secondary school  
without graduating from secondary school, which is designed to  
provide for ~~such~~ those persons:

(a) adult basic education;

- 2 (c) pre-vocational education;
- 3 (d) vocational education;
- 4 (e) technical education;
- 5 (f) general academic education;
- 6 (g) undergraduate academic education

- 8 (h) graduate academic education leading
- 9 to master's and doctor's degrees;

- 10 (i) undergraduate and graduate
- 11 professional education leading to professional degrees;

- 12 (j) continuing education; or

- 13 (k) some combination of the above; and

14 (2) includes public, private, nonprofit,

15 tribal or federally created and proprietary educational

16 institutions and programs of the following types, among

17 others:

- 18 (a) technical and vocational
- 19 institutes;
- 20 (b) junior colleges;
- 21 (c) branch community colleges;
- 22 (d) colleges and universities;
- 23 (e) post-secondary military institutes;
- 24 (f) post-secondary vocational schools;
- 25 (g) adult vocational and pre-vocational

8 (j) the New Mexico campuses of post-  
9 secondary educational institutions that are wholly owned and  
10 controlled by a tribe located in whole or in part in New  
11 Mexico; and

12 B. "state commission" means the state commission
