F. directly, indirectly or through any subterfuge own, operate or control any interest in any wholesale liquor establishment or liquor manufacturing or wine bottling firm; provided that this subsection shall not prevent a retailer from owning stock in any corporation [which] that wholesales, manufactures or bottles alcoholic beverages when he owns the stock for investment purposes only; or

G. sell or supply ice or any alcoholic beverage from a drive-up window that has been refrigerated, cooled or frozen in any manner."
