#### A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THAT THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC EDUCATION CONDUCT A STUDY TO DETERMINE HOW TO ADDRESS THE STUDENT DROPOUT PROBLEM AND TO DEFINE ZERO TOLERANCE.

WHEREAS, students who drop out of school do not have alternative educational opportunities available to them; and

WHEREAS, school districts should direct money toward creating alternative educational opportunities for student dropouts; and

WHEREAS, students are expelled or suspended pursuant to a subjective definition of zero tolerance; and

WHEREAS, a student has the right to understand clearly the basis for expulsion or suspension;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the state department of public
