A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE COMMISSION ON HIGHER EDUCATION TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF PRIVATIZING THE UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO SCHOOL OF LAW.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the commission on higher education study the feasibility, implications and potential savings and .122589.1

costs to the state and its taxpayers of privatizing the university of New Mexico school of law; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the commission report its findings to the appropriate interim committee by November 1, 1998; and
