BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the state department of public education develop and coordinate with the public schools a pilot program; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the state board of education, the state superintendent of public instruction, the public school boards and their superintendents.
